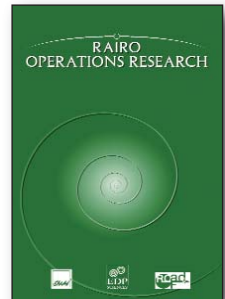
The articles published *RAIRO - Operations Research* span the whole spectrum of pure and applied research on operations research.

Subject areas include:

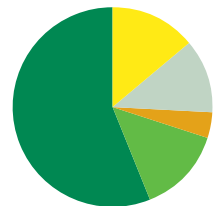
- theory and methodology papers;

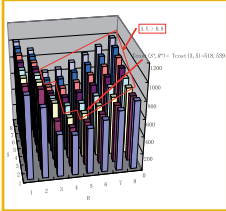
